



2010 Registration Information for Whitefish Bay Club Soccer

WFB Soccer Club offers Club teams from U-6 (K5) through U14 (8th grade) and Select teams from U11 through U18. Both Club and Select players must register through the Milwaukee Kickers website: <http://www.mksc.org/>. Follow the instructions and be sure to choose the correct WFB region – either the Whitefish Bay School District link for Club (Rec) soccer or the Whitefish Bay Select link for Select tryouts/registration.

Priority registration starts May 10th for both the Fall and the following Spring sessions. Registrations are accepted throughout the year, but teams can fill up, so Priority Registration ends June 10th. We submit a number of teams for game scheduling at the end of June. To guarantee a spot on a team or to stay on your current team, please register during priority registration.

Fees:

- 1) Milwaukee Kickers registration fee - varies by age group.
- 2) Kicker WFB region fee - \$40 per player, Whitefish Bay \$80 max per family-if you have more than 2 players in the program, the difference will be refunded post registration.
- 3) Mandatory volunteer buyout fee - \$50 per player. This is refunded after 5 hours of volunteer work per player.
- 4) Late fee - \$30 after June 10th. Note: There is no late fee for U6 or Select/Select tryouts players signing up for Club (Rec) Soccer.

New Players:

- 1) When registering, have your emergency contact, medical information and credit card info handy and plan on 10 minutes of uninterrupted time to register. If you pause for several minutes during the registration process, the system may time you out and you will have to start over! If volunteering for coach, assistant coach, referee or manager, please have risk management information handy (driver's license) during registration.
- 2) New players may indicate a preference to be on a team with one friend (and it helps to have that friend reciprocate). Final team placement is determined by the Age Group Coordinator based on following the WFB Club (Rec) Soccer team formation guidelines. Please see the WFB Club (Rec) General information sheet.

Returning players:

- 1) You will need your login and password that you created when registering your player for the prior season. If you have forgotten this information, there is a link on the login page.
- 2) Review all information in your account and make sure your information is up to date- especially email addresses and the player's grade!

Coaches/Managers:

- 1) Club Coaches are parent volunteers so please consider coaching or assistant coaching! Initial and ongoing training and information resources are provided for coaches by the WFB Soccer Club and the Milwaukee Kickers. U6-U10 Coaches will be provided a Kicker Coaching Curriculum and provided with Curriculum Coaching instruction in Fall and Spring.
- 2) Registration includes a risk management form-please have Drivers license available during registration if volunteering for coach, assistant coach, or manager.

- 3) Please make sure the email address you use for your coach registration is current and correct! This email address will be used for all coach and team related communication. All WFB Club emails go through the Kickers registration system. Be sure use an email address that you have access to as much as possible (i.e. for field closings).
